
ADDENDUM TO THE REPORT ON THE IOTC RECORD OF ACTIVE VESSELS: DATA FOR THE YEAR 2006

This document summarises the information received in accordance with IOTC Resolution 07/04 *Concerning registration and exchange of information on vessels, including flag of convenience vessels, fishing for tropical tunas and swordfish in the IOTC Area of competence.*

Submission of active vessel lists for 2006

Paragraph 1. All Contracting Parties and Non-Contracting Parties cooperating with the IOTC with vessels fishing for tropical tunas and swordfish in the IOTC Area of Competence (hereinafter referred to as 'the Area'), by 30 June every year:

- shall submit to the Secretary a list of their respective vessels greater than 24 m LOA that have fished for tropical tunas and swordfish in the Area during the previous year;
- Shall submit to the Secretary a list of their respective vessels of less than 24 m LOA that have fished for tropical tunas and swordfish outside of their EEZ during the previous year.

Information on the status of reporting relating to IOTC Resolution 07/04 for 2006 is given in Table 1.

Table 1: The record of active vessels for 2006 (IOTC Resolution 07/04): The number and size-class of vessels reported by each CPC (above) or other non CPC (below). A blank square indicates that no data was received and n/a = not applicable. The vessels are classified per length overall, greater than or equal to 24m, less than 24m or unknown for vessels not reporting the size. Data as of June 2008.
